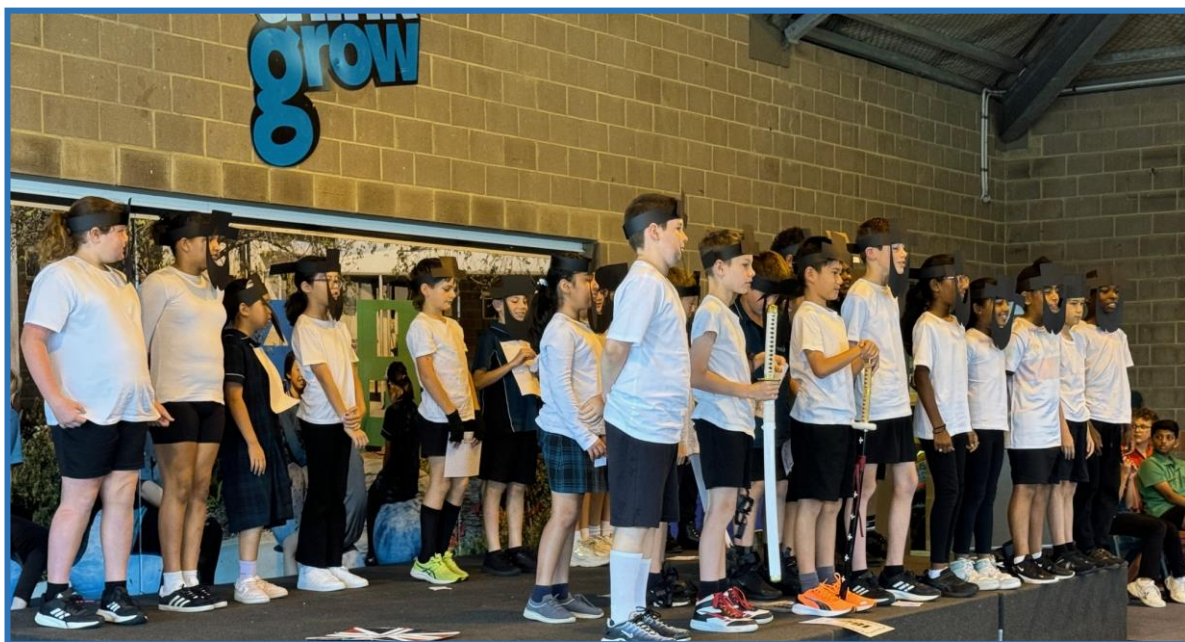

P&C news

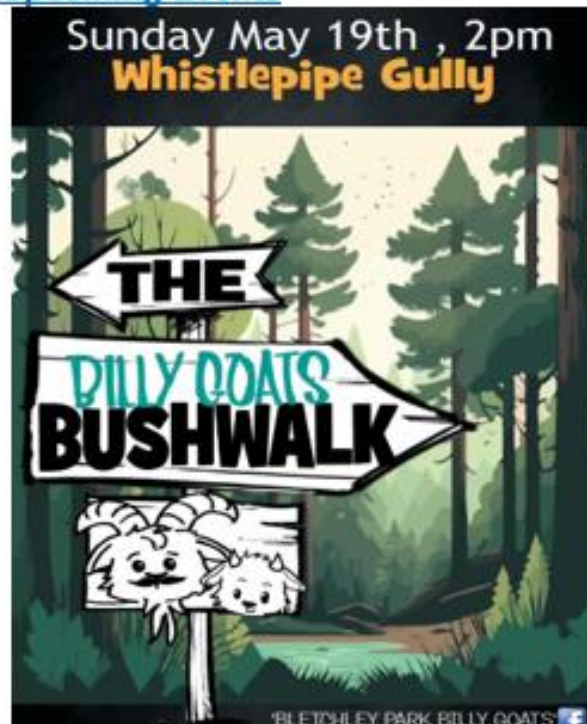
