

FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Not quite halfway through the term, but we are getting close. BPPS has settled into a nice rhythm at the moment, even with the impact of swimming lessons which our Yr 4 – Yr 6 students complete this week; and our PP – Yr 3 commence on Monday 14th August and run for the next two weeks. A very exciting time for our PP students who get their first taste of in term swimming.

Next week the students will also participate in the school funded incursion Yirra Yaakin which will be a great experience for the students. Yirra Yaakin is set on Wadandi Boodja, in the town of Woodich Up Bilya (Margaret River), Lingo Lah Lah follows the adventures of three bestest everest friends, Big Dwert (Dog), Lil Dwert and Koolungar (Child), as they journey around Country and even to Meeka (the Moon) to regain their language, taken from them by Mother Earth and Lingo Dingo as punishment for being mean and unkind. Without their voices they must now learn new ways to communicate! On their quest for forgiveness, they encounter many characters who hold different aspects of language and important lessons about kindness, acceptance, friendship, and the power of words. Lingo Lah Lah is a fun, interactive and joyful romp through our multilingual landscape, with a focus on Noongar language, that will have audiences counting, playing, greeting each other, and even learning how to say “sorry” in other languages. This show will take its audiences on an epic journey that celebrates friendship, empathy and the cultural diversity among us. Lingo Lah Lah is a celebration of all that we are in WA!

Just a reminder to families that students should not be arriving at school prior to 8:15am. We have limited supervision available in the morning and we have an increasing amount of students arriving before this time. Students who do arrive before 8:15am should head to the UCA. Your support is appreciated.
