FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Dear Families

It's been a busy fortnight at Bletchley Park. Our Book Week celebrations were a huge success with staff and students all getting involved; on that note I would like to acknowledge the efforts of our Library Officer Mrs Isgar. It was great to see so many Bletchley families attend our Book Week Assembly and the student parades that followed. Thankyou for making this community such a special place.

This Friday all students from K-6 participate in our Faction Athletics Carnival. The weather looks to be sensational! Please make sure your children come to school with their sunscreen applied; we will have sunscreen available throughout the day also. On Tuesday we had our Jumps and Throws as well as long distance runs. Congratulations to all those students who represented their factions.

On Monday whilst students enjoyed a well-earned day off, staff were busy at our School Development Day. All staff participated in a Cultural Responsiveness session, largely focussed around the Aboriginal Cultural Standard Framework. At Bletchley Park Primary School, we pride ourselves on providing a welcoming and inclusive environment for all families. Staff also examined in detail our 2023 NAPLAN results. This information will be used to inform future planning and school direction.

Next week all students from Years 1-6 will sit their PAT (Progressive Assessment Testing) Reading assessment. This is an online assessment, similar to NAPLAN, that allows us to measure student progress at an individual, class and cohort level. Students will also sit the PAT Mathematics assessment next term. Year 3-6 students will sit the PAT Science and Social and Emotional assessments. Results from these assessments help support teacher judgements and grading come report time. If you would like more information, please talk to your child's class teacher.

Wednesday September 13th, from 2:45pm we are having our annual parent open afternoon. We look forward to having you join us to celebrate your children's learning throughout the year. All year level classes, and specialist classrooms will be open with activities for students to participate in. Each student will have their 'passport' to collect stamps for each room they visit. These can be placed in the box outside the administration for the prize draw at 4:00pm.

Week 9 is a big one as we also acknowledge RUOK? Day. Students are encouraged to wear yellow to mark the day (no donation required). Staff will be having age-appropriate conversations will students around mental health and wellbeing, and how to ask someone RUOK? Students from Years K-3 will receive stickers and balloons, while Year 4-6 students will receive an RUOK? Wristband. We thank you for supporting our Wellbeing journey at BPPS.

Finally, I would like to inform you that Mr Walpole's secondment as Director with Statewide Services has been extended throughout Term 4. Mr Walpole will return in Week 5 of Term 4. Until then I will continue as Acting Principal, with Mrs Renette Roth continuing as Acting Deputy Principal. I thank you for your continued support and understanding.


