- Teachers spend requests:
- Katrina provided a short presentation on the stem cell project and how the
  robots worked. Agreed to give stem committee \$10,000 on the proviso
  that they come back with what they would like to purchase and it will be
  approved. Further discussion and decision to fund what they have asked
  for \$5,600 for 8 robot sets and \$1,600 for 20 oz bots
- Mr Cave: 2 x terrasphere outdoor deluxe 700 table tennis table and accessories \$1448. Approved. School will match x 2
- Josie Millwood: Bongo Drums to value of \$5837.70 Declined in this round
- Sue Bachman: Purchase of lap tops to value of \$15,000. Declined
- ECE Area: Approved \$1000 to be shared across both funding requests for new toys
- Covid 19 and impact on fundraising: To wait and see how things develop but to be cautious around spending at this time
- Container deposit scheme grants: Opportunity to raise funds either by having a collection centre at the school, but reluctance due to possible free for all
- Fathering project hold a collection day and take to refund point, possibility
- Committee agreed to register for the virtual ID
- Fathering project accountability: Confusion around where the fathering project fits. Lots of discussion held. Require Terms of Reference to be completed. Fathering project lead needs to be a member of the P & C.
