WHY WE HAVE VALUES PROGRAM?

Values Education is an educational program that provides schools and teachers with a structured resource to develop and promote core values. Teaching values in school can be a proactive way to manage student behaviour. The program aims to give students effective strategies to help them lead happy and successful lives through developing positive self-esteem and care for others, and establishing good citizenship in the developing years.



FACTION COMPETITION

TED tokens doing my best and respect are linked to the faction completion. The faction competition was created in 2013 to link sports values of sportsmanship and teamwork with the values program.

Students receive one faction point when they receive a doing my best/respect token.

Procedure:

Every Friday the faction captains count the faction pop sticks and combine with middle/senior sport values points and assembly tokens.

At whole school assemblies the Faction Captains give an update of the faction competition.

ROLE OF TED TREAT EVERYONE DECENTLY

TED will continue to promote the values program in the school by attending various events throughout the year including:

TED is a role model to the students and the community on doing my best and respect. TED is a foundation member of Bletchley Park PS and through song at assemblies provides students with the opportunity to participate in dance and affection.



ASSEMBLIES

At whole school assemblies the Faction Captains give an update of the faction competition.

The Faction Captains will provide students who are presented with a values certificate or honor certificate a faction token -

Doing my best: 2 points

Respect: 3 points

At the conclusion of assembly students need to put the faction assembly token into their faction letterbox.



CLASSROOM

The Practical Implementation of the Values Education Program at Bletchley Park Primary School

- ☐ Students receive 'TEDs' tickets from any staff member (teaching and non teaching) around the school.
- ☐ Students place the 'TEDs' tickets in a box in their classroom and prizes are given during block/learning team assemblies. Students exchange their TEDs for a coloured pop stick, which gets posted in a faction mailbox, located in the undercover area.
- □ Several times a term, as outlined on the Assembly Timetable, students from each class are awarded a certificate for having demonstrated the value consistently. These certificates are presented at Friday Parent Assemblies.
